Fees for 2020

Portable and Industrial Batteries and Accumulators

The presented fees are the base for calculating annual amounts payable by the Members to ERP Portugal in consideration of the transfer of the responsibility for batteries waste management.

The price structure is based on the principle “kilograms placed on market” (POM).



The batteries and accumulators POM fees are presented by type and chemical systems and will enter into force from January 1st, 2020 onwards.

The unit value of the fee for Small Dimension Producers was set at € 75.00 per Member.

All these values will be increased by VAT at the legal rate in force.

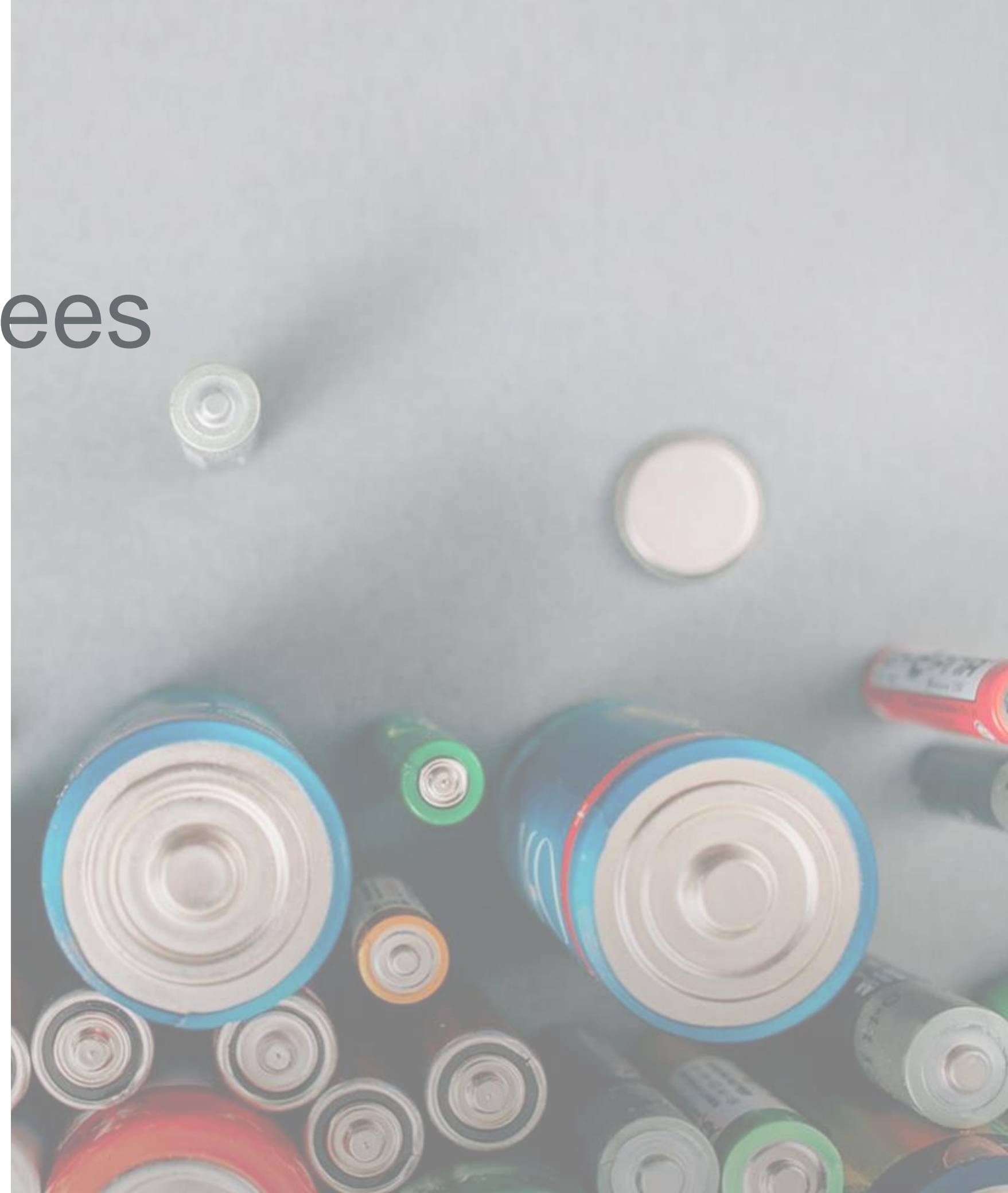
CONDITIONS FOR BA MEMBERS OF SMALL DIMENSION

- Members who have an annual BA placement in the national market weighing 25,00 kilograms or less, based on the following conditions:
 - Payment of Annual Minimum Financial Contribution in the amount of € 75.00. Due at the time of accession, and thereafter on March 20 of each year of membership.
 - Presentation of Annual Declaration submitted at the time of registration, and thereafter between January 1 and March 15 of each year of membership.

- Bonification Model does not apply to members who fall under the conditions of small dimension.

Bonuses Criteria to be applied to base Fees

- A. Customer loyalty – stays with ERP Portugal for the permit period
- B. If joins to more than one stream managed by ERP Portugal
- C. Members which participate in additional prevention and awareness campaigns together with ERP Portugal
- D. Take back of batteries and accumulators waste through ERP Portugal of at least 100 kg per year for recycling (physical collections).



A. Customer loyalty

The loyalty period will be the length of the Permit granted to ERP Portugal, until December 31st, 2021 (permit end period). This criteria aims to provide the Compliance Scheme with a stable membership base that allows it to make investments in collection points network in order to meet the imposed collection targets.

B. Loyalty by joining more than one specific stream

Considering that ERP Portugal manages two specific waste streams and there are synergies between them in terms of overheads, operational costs, IT systems among others, we want to benefit Members that choose to join both streams.

C. Prevention and Awareness

Participate with ERP Portugal in prevention and/or awareness campaigns in order to promote sustainable consumption and selective disposal.

D. Take Back - Waste collections

By asking ERP Portugal to take back the batteries' waste, Members ensure their correct recycling and promote the fulfilment of the collection targets.

The bonuses to be applied to ERP Portugal members which fulfils the established criteria, are as follows:

C	Additional prevention, awareness campaigns with ERP Portugal	1,00%
